Cybersecurity for Your Business

- **Description:** Why rob a bank when a criminal can steal far more while sitting in front of a computer? Beyond just money, the sensitive personal information of both employees and clients is attractive to the cyber thief. Additionally, remote work technologies have provided cybercriminals with new ways to disrupt business and steal what is yours. Sadly, every year millions become victims because they did not know how to protect themselves from cybercrime. By using examples of actual FBI cases, John reveals the ways your business is vulnerable to a cyberattack, the threats inherent with remote technologies, and how you can protect yourself.
- **About John:** John Iannarelli served as an FBI Special Agent for 20 years, during which he was a SWAT team member and participated in the investigations of the Oklahoma City bombing, the 9/11 attack, the shooting of Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords, and the Sony hack. Among his many FBI assignments, John served as the FBI's National Spokesperson, on the Cyber Division Executive staff, and was as an Assistant Special Agent in Charge overseeing all Criminal, Cyber and Counterintelligence investigations. He was recognized with the FBI's Director Award for Distinguished Service.

No Surprises Act

- ▶ **Description:** Most provisions of the No Surprises Act were effective Jan. 1, 2022. This presentation will outline hospital requirements under the No Surprises Act, including good faith estimates, public disclosures, and plan/issuer communications. It will also describe the latest proposed changes to Illinois' surprise billing law, Public Act 096-1523, and discuss how the state law intersects with the federal law. Finally, the presentation will provide an overview of questions and challenges that have arisen over the first three months of implementation, and review outstanding questions that CMS should address with notice and comment rulemaking over the next year
- ▶ **About Cassie:** Cassie Yarbrough is the director of Medicare policy with the Illinois Health & Hospital Association. At IHA, Cassie's work focuses on how Medicare policies and procedures affect Illinois hospitals and the overall healthcare landscape. Additionally, Cassie works hand in glove with IHA's federal lobbyist to research and advocate for federal policies that influence Illinois hospitals and residents. Prior to IHA, Cassie worked for the American Dental Association where she specialized in analysis of oral health policy, including Medicaid policy at both the state and national levels as well as other federal policies that impacted access to and utilization of oral health services. Cassie also served as an analyst with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inspector General. Cassie earned her Master of Public Policy from the University of Chicago, and a Bachelor's in Sociology from the University of Illinois Urbana Champaign.
